RE: Permit Requirements

To: Hamilton County Food Facility

Thank you for obtaining a permit to operate a food facility in Hamilton County. Posting of permits in a conspicuous location is a requirement of Hamilton County ordinance 16-20-8-2(a). This applies to all Bed & Breakfast, Retail Food Establishments and/or Temporary food establishments.

Sec. 16-20-8-2. - Permits.

(a) *General.* It is unlawful for a person to operate any bed and breakfast establishment, retail food establishment and/or temporary food establishment in the county, without first obtaining a valid permit from the health officer. The valid permit must be posted in a conspicuous location in the bed and breakfast establishment, retail food establishment and/or temporary food establishment.

(1) Only persons who comply with the applicable requirements of 410 IAC 7-15.5 and /or 410 IAC 7-24 will be entitled to obtain and keep a permit.

(2) A separate permit shall be required for each bed and breakfast establishment, retail food establishment and/or temporary food establishment operated or to be operated by any person.

(3) A permit issued under this chapter is not transferable.

(4) A bed and breakfast establishment and/or retail food establishment permitted by the county health department shall be considered registered as required in IC16-42-1-6.

(b) *Permit period.* A permit for a bed and breakfast establishment and/or retail food establishment shall be issued for a term beginning January 1, and/or before commencement of operation, and expiring December 31, of the same year and shall be applied for by the person and/or operator annually.

(1) A permit for a temporary food establishment shall be for the term of one continuous operation
