In response to your recommendation that Pig's Tale Charcuterie LLC., be considered for the CIS Program and as per 9 CFR 321.3 part 332, 381.187, and 381 subpart Z; a cooperative review of the facility, their programs, and records were conducted on March 16, 2023.

On Thursday, March 16, 2023, an exit meeting was conducted. Mr. and Mrs. Reed (Owners) were thanked for their cooperation in providing documents, programs, and involvement in the survey. Mr. Reed was reminded that he could not begin CIS operations nor use the SEIN/SEPIN inspection legends until I or another FSIS official informed him through the Indiana Board of Animal Health, Meat and Poultry Inspection Division, that the Agency had selected the establishment into the CIS program. He was also reminded to contact his distributors to get the Letters of Guarantee (LOG) for his support, contact the property manager for the pest control company, and look at incorporating a Food Defense Plan.

Based on the review and the recommendation from the Selected Establishment Coordinator, a determination has been made that Establishment 141 SEIN/SEPIN, Pig's Tale Charcuterie LLC., is able to meet all federal standards and has been selected to participate in the Cooperative Interstate Program.
